# Getting Started: Researching Jefferson County, Pennsylvania

## 1. Learn the County Basics

- Formed 1804 from Lycoming County; organized 1830.
- Attached to Westmoreland (1804–1806) and Indiana (1806–1830) for early records.
- County seat: Brookville.
- Boundaries stable since formation.

### 2. Identify What You Need

- Birth, marriage, or death record
- Land or deed record
- Probate or guardianship
- Census or tax record
- Military or pension file
- Church or cemetery record
